

Admission for Foreign Nationals (Ph.D./M.Tech.) at Civil Engg. Dept. IIT Bombay

[as per 285th DPGC meeting dated 10.01.2024]

Eligibility criteria of Ph.D. Programme for Foreign Nationals in Department of Civil Engg. at IIT Bombay

1. Candidate should be from a recognized foreign university with a first class or equivalent (minimum 60% marks or minimum grade point 6.0 out of 10.0 scale or equivalent) in Bachelor Degree and Master degree. The marks obtained on other scale will be proportioned accordingly.
2. Foreign Nationals with qualifying degree(s) from Indian Universities/ Institutes should satisfy the eligibility criteria set for Indian Nationals (For more details, visit <https://www.iitb.ac.in/newacadhome/phd.jsp>)
3. Candidates applying for direct PhD after Bachelor degree (without Master degree), should have excellent academic background with minimum two years of experience in the relevant field. Experience certificate needs to be submitted.
4. If medium of instruction is not English (during higher education), a pass in any one of the following two tests will be required.
 - a. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), administered by the Educational Testing Service in the US, in which scores of at least 580 overall and 4.0 in the Test of Written English are required. The computer based test requires scores of at least 240 overall and 4.0 in essay writing. The internet based test requires scores of at least 95 overall with a minimum score of 20 in writing.
 - b. The International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) test, administered by the British Council, in which scores of 6 or more in each section and an overall score of 6.5 are required.
5. Good research proposal in the area applying for Ph.D.
6. Write-up on master degree work along with evaluation scheme or grade obtained, if applicable.
7. Complete application should be submitted with the following documents. Incomplete application will be rejected without evaluation. All the documents should be in English or translated in English.
 - a. Cover letter by the candidate
 - b. Curriculum Vitae
 - c. Ph.D. research proposal
 - d. Summary of master degree work and contribution
 - e. Grade/Mark sheets
 - f. Proof of English proficiency (if applicable)
 - g. Degree certificate
 - h. Experience certificate (if applicable)
 - i. Detailed curriculum of bachelor degree program
 - j. Specialization preference in the order of priority (maximum two)
 - k. Letter of recommendation (minimum 2 letters)
 - l. Copy of the passport
8. Shortlisted Ph.D. candidate would be called for interview through video- conferencing by the respective group.

Eligibility criteria of M.Tech. Programme for Foreign Nationals in Department of Civil Engg. at IIT Bombay

1. Candidate should be from a recognized foreign university with a first class or equivalent (minimum 60% marks or minimum grade point 6.0 out of 10.0 scale or equivalent) in Bachelor Degree. The marks obtained on other scale will be proportioned accordingly.
2. Foreign Nationals with qualifying degree(s) from Indian Universities/ Institutes should have a valid GATE score.
3. Candidate should have engineering degree (BS/BE/B.Tech./B.Eng.) or equivalent degree.
4. If medium of instruction is not English (during higher education), a pass in any one of the following two tests will be required.
 - a. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), administered by the Educational Testing Service in the US, in which scores of at least 580 overall and 4.0 in the Test of Written English are required. The computer based test requires scores of at least 240 overall and 4.0 in essay writing. The internet based test requires scores of at least 95 overall with a minimum score of 20 in writing.
 - b. The International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) test, administered by the British Council, in which scores of 6 or more in each section and an overall score of 6.5 are required.
5. Candidates should have demonstrated good record in course work related to the applied M.Tech specialization during Bachelor degree.
6. Complete application should be submitted with the following documents. Incomplete application will be rejected without evaluation. All the documents should be in English or translated to English.
 - a. Cover letter by the candidate
 - b. Curriculum Vitae
 - c. Grade/Mark sheets
 - d. Proof of English proficiency (if applicable)
 - e. Degree certificate
 - f. Detailed curriculum of bachelor degree program
 - g. Specialization preference in the order of priority (maximum 2)
 - h. Letter of recommendation (minimum 2 letters)
 - i. Copy of the passport
