Sub. : Guidelines for Summer Courses

The Senate in its 239th Meeting held on 9th October 2019 resolved to approve the following interalia modifications in the **guidelines for Summer Courses** for UG students.

“(a) A student can take up to a maximum of 24 credits of Mandatory Courses (core + hss + department & institute electives) in which s/he has received FR/DX/DR/W grade. However, if a student accumulates two (or more) “FR” in Mandatory Courses and does not find enough courses (totaling up to 24 credits) in a summer term, s/he can take a maximum of two Mandatory Courses in which s/he has NEVER registered.

(b) Courses requiring pre-requisites need instructor’s approval in case the student has not completed the pre-requisites.

(c) NO restrictions (i.e. #a) will apply after the expiry of the regular programme duration (4 years for B.Tech, B.Des. and B.S., 5 years for DD).”

The changes will be effective from Summer Term 2019-20.
