Sub.: Guidelines for Summer Courses

The Senate in its 239th Meeting held on 9th October 2019 resolved to approve the following interalia modifications in the guidelines for Summer Courses for UG students.

"(a) A student can take up to a maximum of 24 credits of Mandatory Courses (core + hss + department & institute electives) in which s/he has received FR/DX/DR/W grade. However, if a student accumulates two (or more) "FR" in Mandatory Courses and does not find enough courses (totaling up to 24 credits) in a summer term, s/he can take a maximum of two Mandatory Courses in which s/he has NEVER registered.

(b) Courses requiring pre-requisites need instructor's approval in case the

student has not completed the pre-requisites.

(c) NO restrictions (i.e. #a) will apply after the expiry of the regular programme duration (4 years for B.Tech, B.Des. and B.S., 5 years for DD)."

The changes will be effective from Summer Term 2019-20.
