1. Interview for CE3, CE5, CE6 and CE7 will be conducted in-person (offline) on 12th & 13th May 2026. Those who are having University exams on 12th & 13th May 2026, with prior permission,

may be allowed on **Sunday 10th May, 2026** from 9:00 am onwards if there is valid proof. Email request should be sent by 8th May, 2026 to office@civil.iitb.ac.in.

2. The candidate should be ready with all documents prescribed by the Academic office, IIT Bombay. These documents should be exhibited/shown during the Interview.
3. If the candidate is not available on interview days, the interview gets CANCELLED for that candidate and no further queries in this context will be entertained.
4. The information provided by the candidate in the application cannot be changed.
5. The candidate will be considered only for the **first TWO** choices of specializations as opted by the candidate in order of their preference in the application form.
6. The selection will be based on the performance in the interview and GATE score. The decision of the committee is final and cannot be changed under any circumstances.
